## DISCOVERED



Howard Carter uncovers the tomb of the Pharaoh Tutankhamun on November 22<sup>nd</sup> 1922. Funded by Lord Carnarvon, Carter finds the biggest ever collection of priceless Ancient Egyptian treasures in the Valley of the Kings on the West Bank at Luxor.

Born in 1874, Carter has spent a life time studying Egyptology, in the hopes of finding great treasures and solving the mysteries of the Ancient Egyptians.

contains a stone Sarcophagus which has three gold coffins nested inside each other. Inside the final one is the mummy of the boy-king, Pharaoh Tutankhamun.

The discovery was not hindered by the curse found on the tomb, warning people from entering, it read "He who enters shall be swiftly visited by the wings of death."
